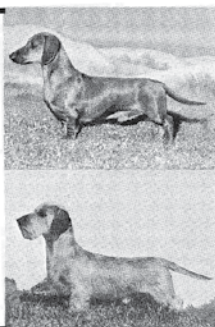

Summer Safety



With summer coming it is important to pay attention to our dogs and their wellbeing during the hot temperatures of summer. Our dachshunds are low to the ground and react to the heat very quickly.

HEATSTROKE

Heatstroke can be the serious and often fatal result of a dog's prolonged exposure to excessive heat. Below are

the signs of heatstroke and the actions you should take if your dog is overcome.

Early Stages:

- Heavy panting.
- Rapid breathing.
- Excessive drooling.
- Bright red gums and tongue.
- Standing 4-square, posting or spreading out in an attempt to maintain balance.

Advanced Stages:

- White or blue gums.
- Lethargy, unwillingness to move.
- Uncontrollable urination or defecation.
- Labored, noisy breathing.
- Shock.

If your dog begins to exhibit signs of heatstroke, you should immediately try to cool the dog down:

- Apply rubbing alcohol to the dog's paw pads.
- Apply ice packs to the groin area.
- Hose down with water.
- Allow the dog to lick ice chips or drink a small amount of water.
- Offer Pedialyte to restore electrolytes.

Check your dog's temperature regularly during this process. Once the dog's temperature has stabilized at between 100 to 102 degrees, you can stop the cool-down process.

If you cannot get the dog cooled down and you begin to see signs of advanced heatstroke, take the dog to the veterinarian immediately.

English Judge Views Competition In U.S.

More & Better Miniatures Would Be Shown If Varieties Were Separated, Says Visitor

"I feel that the Miniatures in America should be given a separate variety," writes Mrs. Muriel F. Rhodes, the English woman who judged Longhairs and Wirehairs at the Westbury KA show last fall.

Mrs. Rhodes is public relations officer of the DC of England, Honorable Secretary of the Long-Haired DC of England, and is on the committee of the Wire-Haired DC (England).

In a letter to an American breeder of Miniatures, Mrs. Hodes says: "It is very hard for these tinies to have to be shown against the Standards. I watched with great interest the Miniatures at the shows I visited when in the U.S., and of course had the pleasure of going over some very nice ones when I judges at Westbury.

Bone, height, shoulder-set in U.S. miniatures faulted

"I saw quite a number that I felt would have been improved very much if they could have been a little heavier. "The weight limit in England is 11 pounds, and I like to see Miniatures around the 10 1/2 pound mark."

"In each of the varieties I saw some excellent Miniatures, good bodies, low to ground, good heads and movement, but I did see quite a number which in my opinion were light of bone, inclined to be high on the leg, and shoulders set far too forward for me.

Says U.S. Miniatures Wires "Have a Little Way to Go"

"It is interesting to note the registration figures for all the six varieties of Dachshunds in England as given in the October issue of the British Kennel Gazette. Up to that time of year they were: Longs 269, Miniature Longs 819,

Smooths 1149, Miniature Smooths 1512, Wires 98, Miniature Wires 193. So it will be seen that in all the coats the Miniature registration is higher than the Standards.

"If Miniature breeders in the U.S. had their own separate variety, I feel sure they would be encouraged to breed and show more. From what I saw at a number of shows, I feel the Miniatures in America are quite ready for a separate variety. The Miniature Wires, I feel, still have a little way to go yet.

All English Miniatures Now Limited to 11 Pounds

"The weight limit for Miniature Wires in England now is 11 pounds, the same as in the other two varieties. Up to this year, it has been 12 pounds. It has taken a few years to bring them into line with the other two varieties from the weight viewpoint, as quite a number of the Miniature Wires shown a few years ago tended to go over weight. In some cases, Miniature Wires were kept underweight for show purposes, and consequently they did not look their best. At present there are very few over 11 pounds, and a large number between 10 and 10 1/2 pounds. "I saw in America several Miniature Wires who would have gone to the top had they carried more condition. From a judge's point of view, I feel it is very difficult judging one against the other "It is rather discouraging for a Miniature breeder when his very good exhibit is put down to a good Standard. I feel the separate classification would give Miniature breeders encouragement to go all out to breed top-flight exhibits. They would do this if they felt the top honors in the show ring could come their way a little more often."

She loved her 3 sons Brad, Frank and Jeff and often talked of her 4th son Jim Gorski. Frank and Jim served in the Marine Corps together and after they were honorably discharged Jim, who was from Massachusetts went to visit Frank in Florida for a few days and stayed 3 years. He lived with Marcella and her husband and sons and became part of her family.

Marcella was a very strong willed and intelligent Lady. When she decided to do something she always made it happen and was the very BEST at anything she did.

She left a lasting, living impression on everyone she met, in the dog show world and forever on my heart. I will love and miss her for the rest of my life.

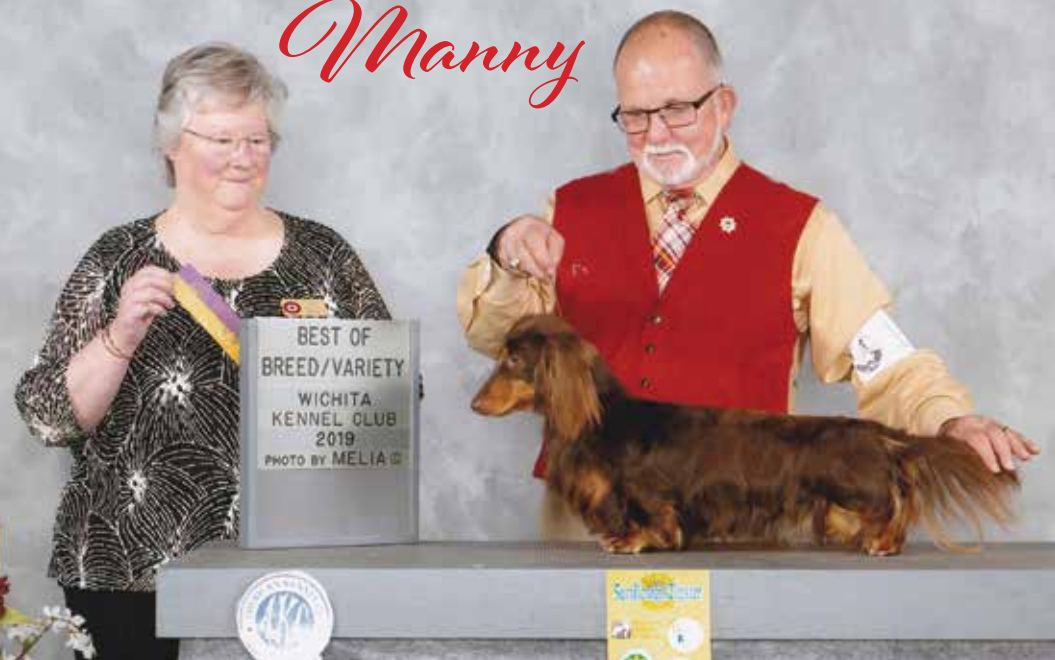
