

Thank you for your interest in reserving an RV space at Purina Farms.

- Check-in time is 3p.m. on the arrival date shown on your reservation confirmation
- Check-out time is 6p.m. on the departure date shown on your reservation confirmation.

Purina Farms offers 2 different RV lots on property. The Full-Service Purina Event Center RV lot offers water and sewer as well as 30 and 50amp electric*. The Electric only Main Show Field RV lot offers 30 and 50amp electric.

Quiet time in the RV area is from 11:00PM to 6:00AM. Any RVs arriving between these hours will be placed in a holding lot until after 6:00AM when they can then move to their designated spots or after 3:00PM depending on the designated arrival date on the reservation.

Day camping is available in 3 different designated lots on property. Spaces are limited and are available on a first-come; first-served basis while there is still availability. Day campers must vacate the lots by 11p.m. on the same day of arrival. Day campers do not need a reservation, but they must abide by all guidelines and be entered/participating in an event on property.

The first night of your overnight camping reservations for the Three Rivers Kennel Club must start no earlier than September 11, 2022 and must end by September 18, 2022. There is a nightly charge of \$40 in the Full-Service Purina Event Center Lot* and \$25 in the Electric Only Main Show Field RV Lot. Overnight Camper Information

Thank you for requesting an overnight camping space in one of the Purina Farms designated RV lots. Our RV Engagement Specialist will respond back to your reservation request within 3-5 business days to let you know whether your reservation is confirmed. Reservations are taken on a first-come; first-served basis and are assigned based on length of equipment (rig) and space availability. If confirmed, you will receive an emailed confirmation that must be shown upon arriving at the front security gate at Purina Farms. You will also receive instructions on how to pay for your space. Full payment by credit card must be received before the space can be confirmed and finalized. Credit cards only.

Check-in time is 3p.m. on the arrival date shown on your reservation confirmation and check out time is 6p.m. on the departure date shown on your reservation confirmation.

Any RVs bigger than 50' must reserve a spot in the full-service Purina Event Center lot. Max size of RV on property is 55'. Tow vehicles are not factored into the length of the spaces as they must be unhooked.

Spaces are refundable if cancelled more than 3 days out from the arrival date listed on the reservation confirmation. Otherwise, no refunds will be given. Spaces are non-transferable.

Please note that RV reservations are only accepted for those entered (or those who have dogs/cats entered) in an event that has contracted space which includes the overnight camping lots. Upon request, participants must be prepared to show proof of event entry upon arrival at Purina Farms.

The Purina Farms RV lots are only open to vehicles specifically designed with overnight sleeping accommodations including motorhomes, fifth wheels and travel trailers.

RV rental reservations must terminate Mon-Saturday. Rental providers won't pick up or drop off on Sundays. Rentals may ONLY be moved by the rental companies. Plan accordingly with the supplier if you have reserved more than one space during your stay.



7 Easy Ways to Keep Your Senior Dog Happy

PROVIDE APPROPRIATE EXERCISE

If you were to give older dogs a choice, they would likely skip jogging marathons and mountain hikes. But increasing age doesn't have to mean decreasing activity. Senior dogs still want to play games, get exercise, and go out to sniff the world every day. Even if they need a little encouragement,

it's important to keep up their strength and muscle tone. Stiff joints need all the support they can get.

The trick is moderation. Your senior dog would like you to keep them limber, prevent weight gain, encourage their appetite, and maintain fitness all while being aware of their limitations. Find the right

activity for your senior dog. Consider slower strolls, low impact activities like swimming, age-appropriate canine calisthenics like platform work, or gentle games of fetch or hideand-seek.

KEEP YOUR DOG'S MIND SHARP

Senior dogs can suffer from age-related cognitive decline, including cognitive dysfunction syndrome, which is all the more reason to provide lots of enrichment opportunities. In fact, mental stimulation is a surefire way to prevent boredom, encourage engagement with you and the environment, and keep your dog happy.

Thankfully, many types of physical exercise provide mental exercise as well. For example, most senior dogs love sniff walks where you let them explore at their own pace and track every scent. They also love puzzle toys that challenge them to solve a problem to obtain a toy or treat. And what dog isn't yearning for a snuffle

mat? Trick training is fun enrichment too.

Make Your Home Accessible

Senior dogs want you to know it can be hard for them to navigate their environment. Mobility issues like arthritis, stiff joints, or other painful conditions mean the things they once did with ease, like jumping into the back of the car, are challenging now. Stairways and slippery surfaces, like hardwood floors, can be particularly tricky. The struggle can even erode your dog's confidence.

Your older dog would truly appreciate it if you made your home more accessible for them. What about adding carpets for better grip? Or providing traction with a yoga mat or anti-slip rug pad on slippery floors or in front of food and water dishes. Pet stairs will help your dog get on and off furniture safely, and a ramp is wonderful for getting in and out of the car.

PROVIDE THE RIGHT DOG BED

Unlike in their younger days, older dogs can't get comfy curled up on the floor. Hard surfaces are unforgiving, and the couch might be too far of a jump. Your senior dog would love it if you provided thick, high-quality dog beds around the house. Then they can snooze in comfort and get some restorative sleep while staying nearby.

If your dog has joint issues like arthritis, consider an orthopedic bed or one made of memory foam for joint support. Or what about a heated bed or a heating pad on top of the bed? They're great for soothing stiffness and aches. Dogs who feel the cold love them too.

WATCH OUT FOR WEATHER EXTREMES

Speaking of feeling the cold, senior dogs can't tolerate the same temperatures as younger dogs. They want you to know



their bodies are more sensitive to hot and cold conditions, so they would love it if you would help them stay comfortable. That could mean a coat or sweater in the winter, even inside the house. And for the summer, consider air conditioning or a fan indoors, and provide constant access to shade and cool, fresh drinking water outdoors. No matter the season, watch how long you spend outside with your dog on days with extreme weather.

ADJUST YOUR DOG'S DIETSenior dogs have different nutritional requirements than

other life stages. For example, older dogs are less active so need fewer calories. Overfeeding leads to obesity which burdens aging joints and can lead to other health concerns. Your senior pet might benefit from easier-to-digest ingredients as well. Or consider switching to wet food. The higher water content is good for the kidneys and its softer texture is easier on aging teeth. Medical conditions can also impact diet choice and the use of supplements like fish oil for joint inflammation. Talk to your veterinarian about the best nutrition options for your dog.

PROVIDE EXTRA GROOMING SESSIONS

Senior dogs want you to know they would appreciate a bit of extra grooming. As they stiffen with age, it can be hard for them to reach every area of their body, so help prevent matting with regular brushing and hair cuts. Don't forget about increasing the frequency of nail trims too. As your senior dog is likely less active, their nails won't naturally wear down the same.

Grooming sessions are also the perfect time to examine your dog for any health changes like lumps or bumps which become more common with age. These could simply be fat deposits, but they may also be cancer, so it's important to catch them as soon as possible. And finally, grooming is wonderful bonding time. Keep grooming positive and pleasant and your senior dog will soak up the pampering. After all, every dog adores love and attention, especially seniors.



The First Official Olympic Mascot Was a Beloved Breed

National Purebred Dog Day*

In 1972, Munich's Summer Games saw the first ever inclusion of an official Olympic mascot in the form of "Waldi," a Dachshund selected for attributes described as required for Olympic athletes: Resistance, tenacity and agility.

"Waldi" was based on Cherie von Birkenhof, a real longhaired Dachshund that Munich Games Organizing Committee President, Willi Daume, had given to Félix Lévitan, the International Sports Press Association President in 1970. "Cherie," was the model for Waldi's creator, German designer, Otl Aicher (who also participated in the logo design for German airline, Lufthansa).

According to the book, The Olympic Marathon, the 1972 Olympic marathon route corresponded to the shape of the dog-mascot. The head of the

dog faced west, with athletes running counter-clockwise starting at the back of the dog's neck and continuing around the ears. "Waldi's" mouth was represented by the path going through Nymphenburg Park, its front feet were represented by the run though the Hirschgarten. The belly was the main downtown street in Munich, and its rear feet, rear end and tail were all in the

English Garden. The athletes continued along the "back" of the dog and entered the Olympic Stadium.

The concept of "Waldi" was born at a Munich Games Organizing Committee Christmas party where those attending were given crayons, sheets of paper and modeling clay with which to produce their mascot designs.
